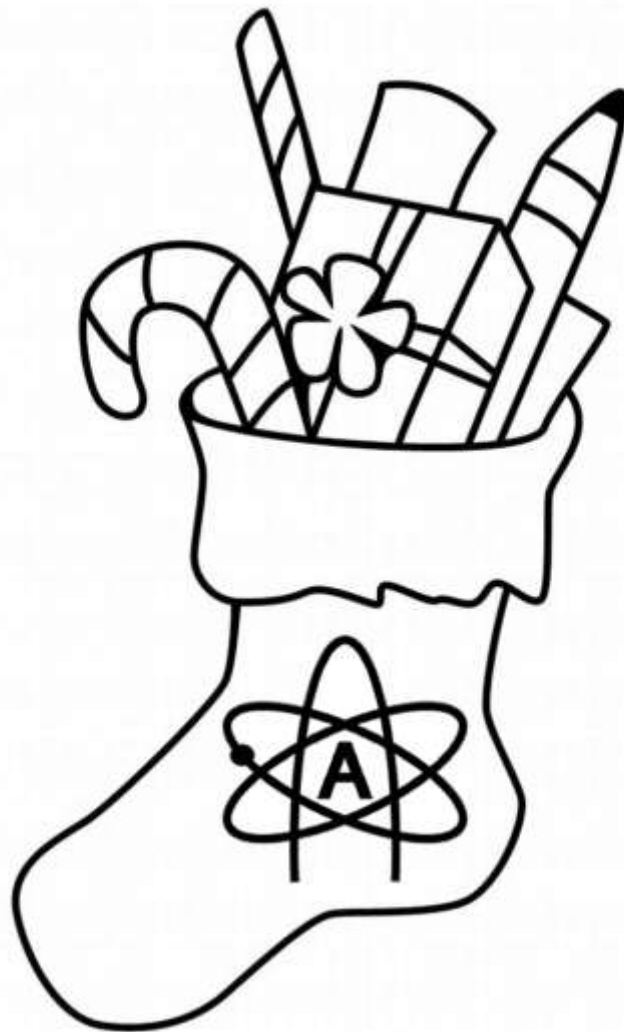

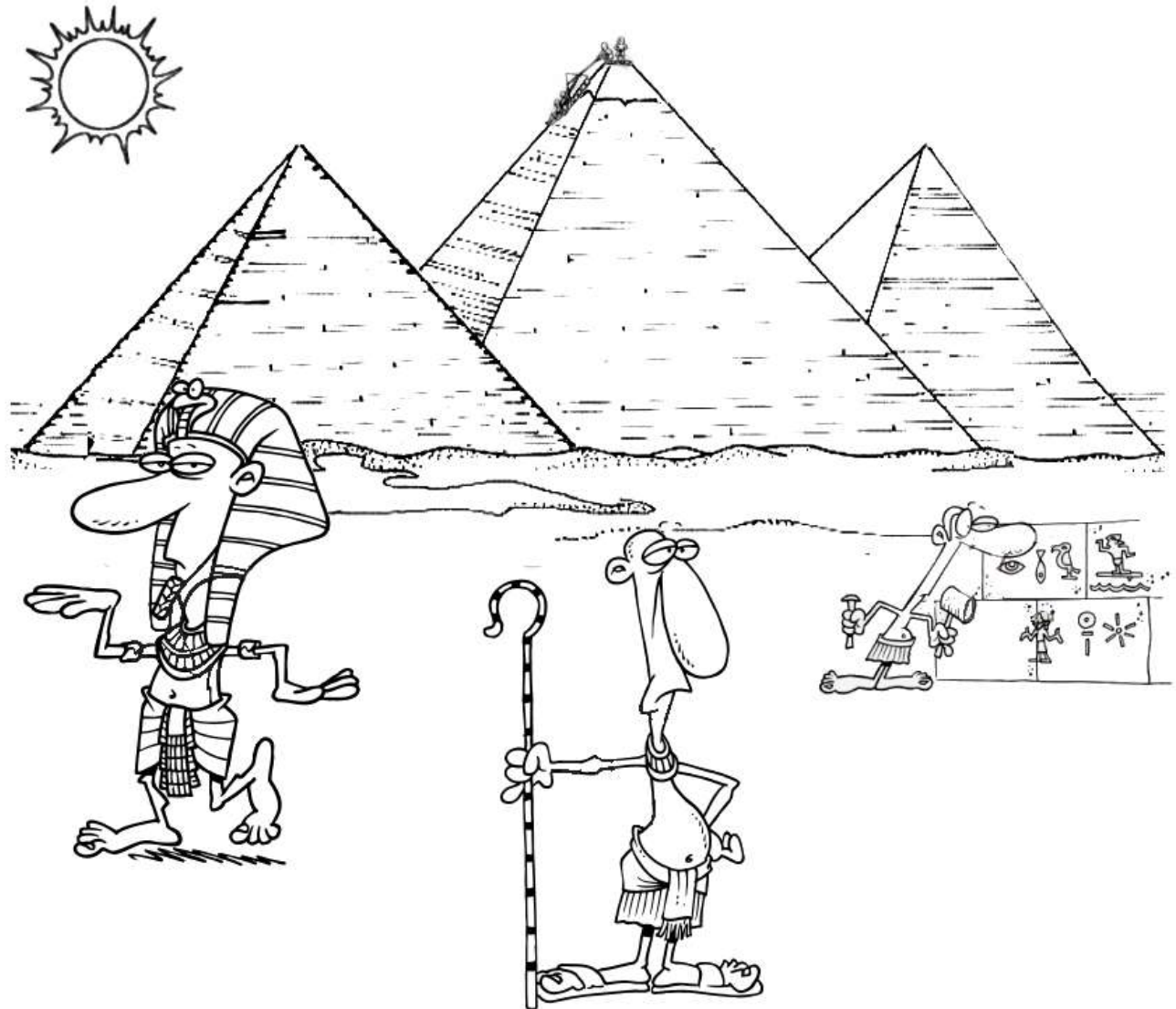

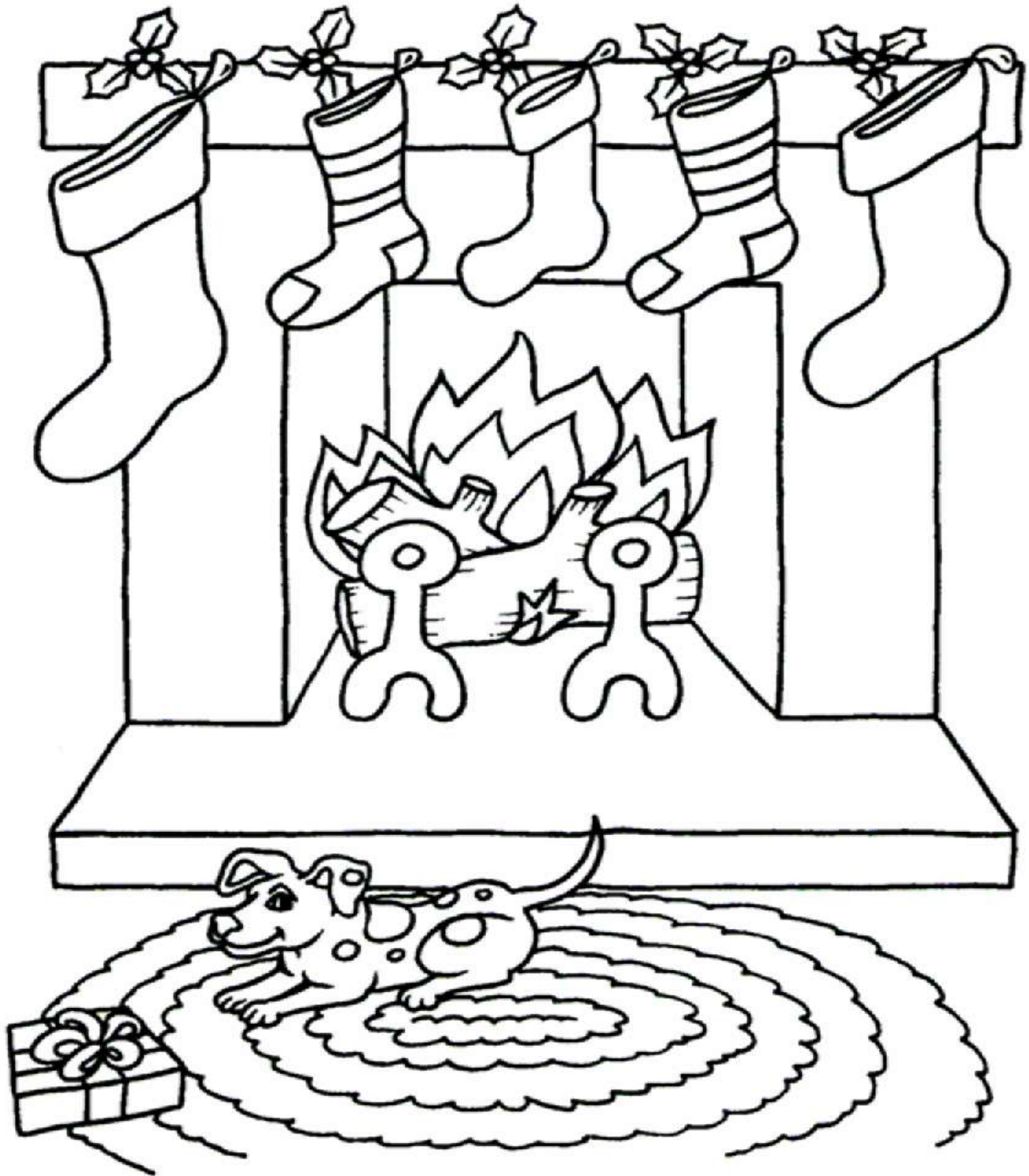
On the darkest, longest night of the year,
we gather to share joy, gifts, and cheer.



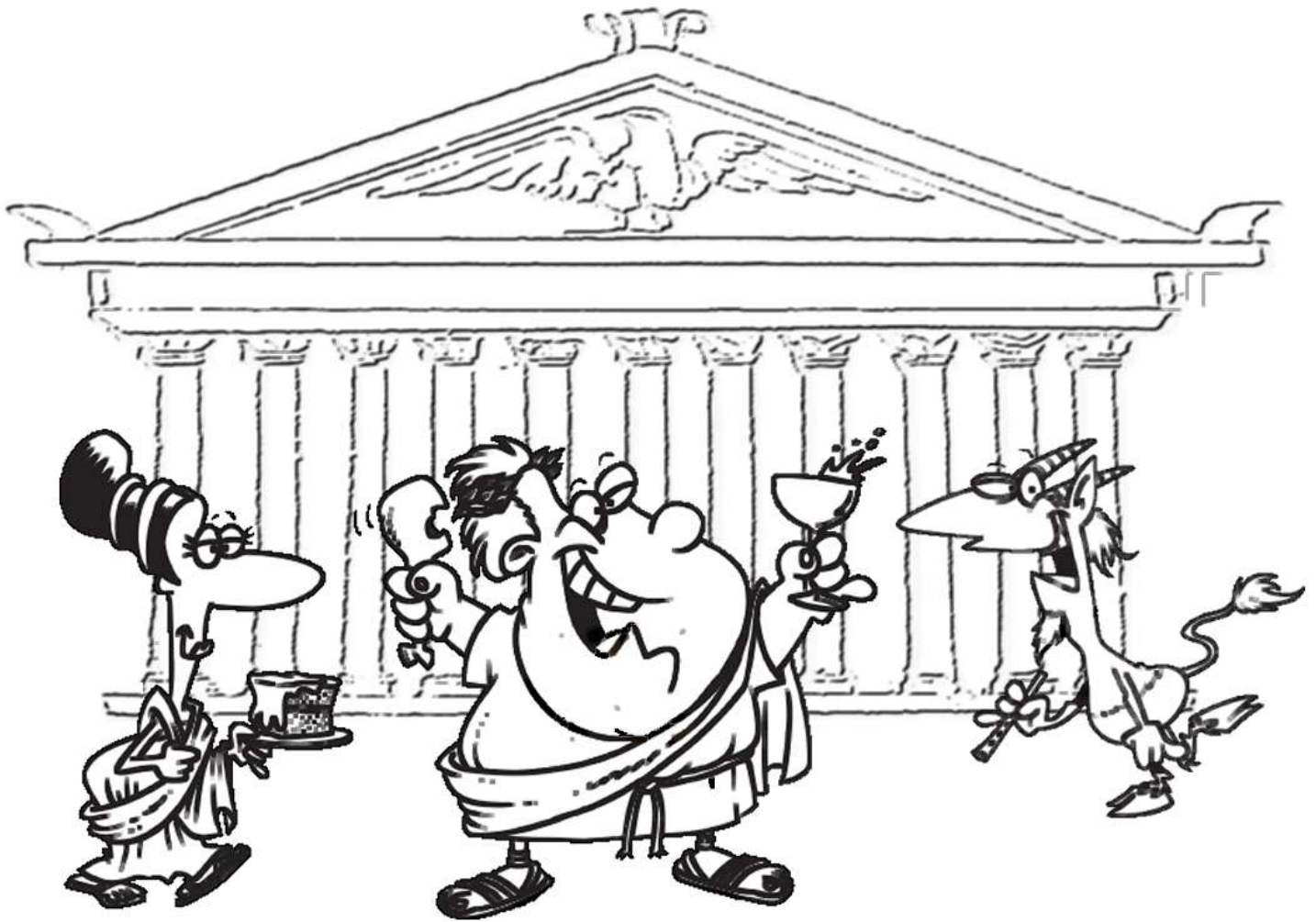
It is a custom as old as a custom can be.
Even for atheists like you and me.



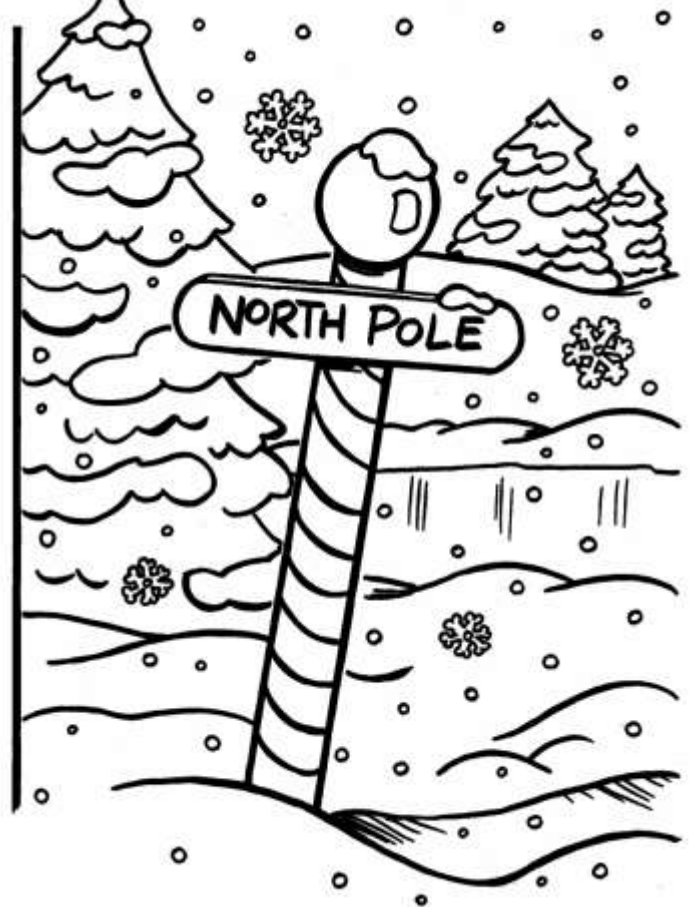
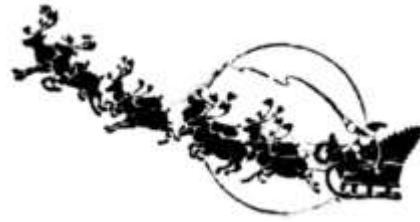
Winter Solstice is due to Earth's axial tilt,
Mapped by ancients in the temples they built.



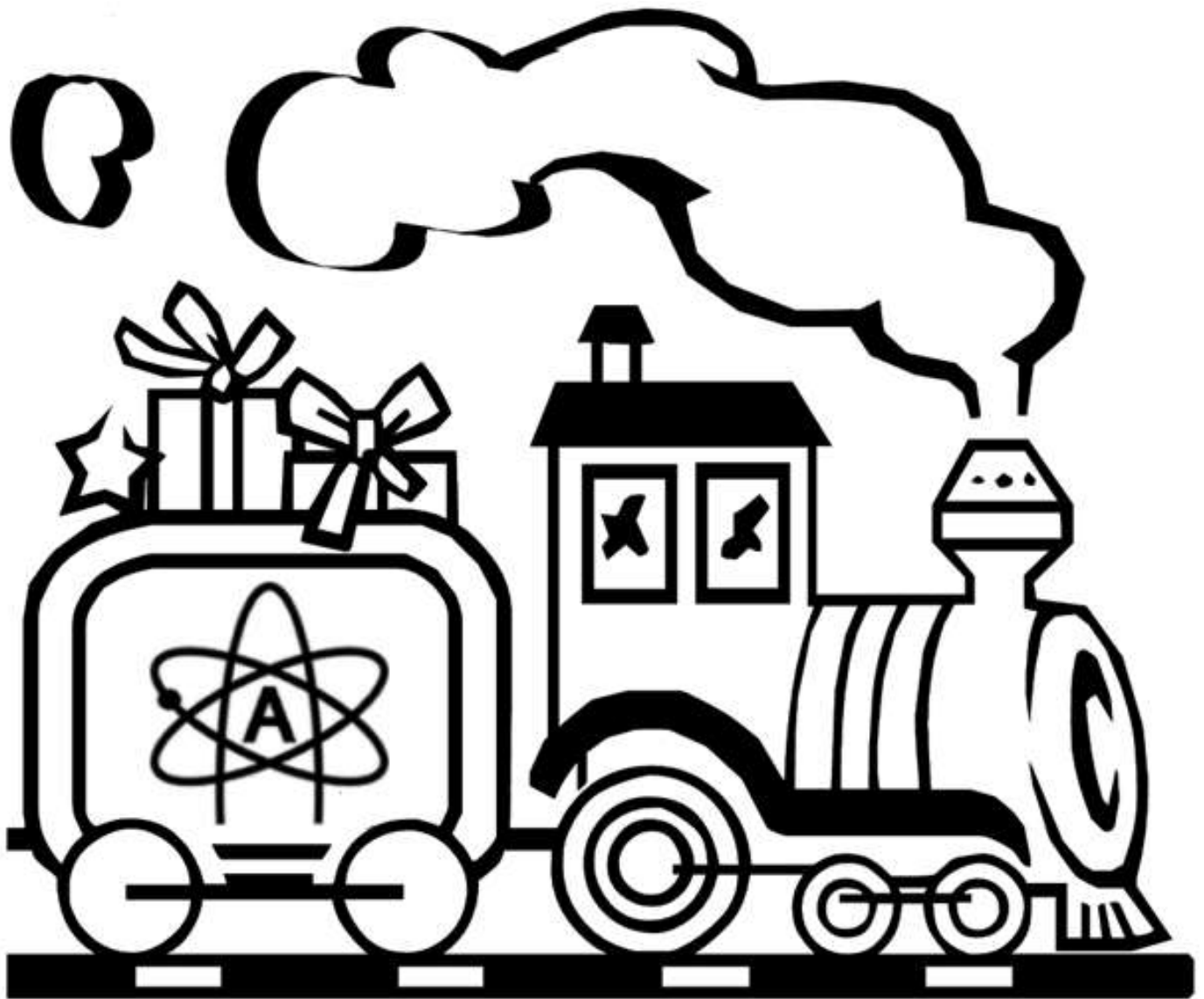
The Jews deserve credit for evergreen leafs.
